Warning Letter of Intent

With this letter I want to remind once again that essence of my claim lies in the very big difference between the information about the sales of my books received from the Taylor & Francis royalty department (Mr. Stephen Kruszewski) and the sales-royalties reports that I have received by mail for 15 years. This difference is 925 copies sold, for which I did not receive a royalty of \$ 6,600.

I have written many times about this problem to the staff of the Taylor & Francis and asked to pay this royalty to me. During the months of correspondence, I have never received any response at all to this very simple, very clear and very particular claim of mine. Instead of answering this particular problem, I received answers that had nothing to do with the essence of my claim.

Turning to the management of the Taylor & Francis, I was hoping to get a clear answer to my specific claim. Instead, I get from you again all the same tables and all the same answers that I have already received from the Taylor & Francis staff and which have nothing to do with my claim.

If you do not want to answer my particular very clear and very simple claim, then I have no other choice but to go to court with a lawsuit for a much larger amount than \$ 6,600 (in compensation for moral damage).

With this letter, I notify you of the transfer of all documents to my attorney, who will prepare a lawsuit on 100 thousand dollars in case of failure to receive confirmation from you of readiness to pay me \$ 6.600 in royalty arrears during one month.
